Starter

The passage we are going to study today was written roughly 500 years before Jesus was even born. Isaiah was a prophet which means that God revealed special truth to him that he shared with the people of his day. When he shared this word he was outlining what the nation needed to look for while anticipating their messiah, their savior.
